

## FUTSAL SA FUTSAL CODE OF CONDUCT

Futsal SA is affiliated with and is a member of the Football Federation of Australia's National Futsal Commission.

By applying for registration with Futsal SA, player accepts responsibility for complying with the Code of Conduct as detailed below.

That player also agrees to any decision made by Futsal SA as a consequence of players' found to be in breach of the Code of Conduct.

These may include and are not limited to:

- Ejection from the court of play
- Fine or suspension by Club/Team
- Fine or suspension by Futsal SA Committee
- Appropriate legal proceedings civil or criminal for conduct unlawful under State of Federal Law.
- (Take particular note of paragraph 9 below.)

## **Code of Conduct - Players**

Whilst performing their duties as members of a team associated with a member or affiliate of the Football Federation of Australia's National Futsal Commission, players will:

- 1. Act respectfully towards their own and opposing officials Clubs/Teams Officials.
- 2. Respect and follow the directions of coaching staff, match and club officials.
- 3. Act respectfully towards all match officials and referees at all times.
- 4. Abusive language is unacceptable and will not be tolerated, penalties apply.
- 5. Avoid individual or collective behavior, which may reasonably: held by spectators to be offensive.
- 6. Avoid all acts likely to incite spectators to violence or disorder.
- 7. Make no detrimental statements in public in respect of performance of any match officials.
- 8. Respect all the facilities in the Recreation Centre and all equipment of their own and opposing Clubs/Teams.
- 9. Take notice that violent behaviour towards any player, match or club official or spectator is at all times unacceptable and renders a player liable to serious consequences, as is any sexual, racial and other form of harassment, as described in the Harassment Policy of the FFA and NFC.

Futsal SA reserves the right to refuse any team nomination and to remove individual players and/or team for any breach of The Code of Conduct.
